



MCAO INVESTIGATIONS DIVISION 2010 INTERNAL COMPLAINT SUMMARY

Detectives and non-sworn employees of the Maricopa County Attorneys Office Investigations Division maintain the highest standards of integrity and honesty. It is the policy of the Maricopa County Attorneys Office to provide an annual summary of the completed citizen complaints and Professional Standards investigations to the public.

The following is the list of completed complaints/investigations made against Investigations Division sworn and non-sworn employees in 2010.

Citizen Complaints:

There were no Citizen Complaints received during the calendar year of 2010.

Internal Investigations:

IA 10-01: It is alleged that a Detective struck another Detective during a training exercise. The allegation was partially **Sustained** in that it was determined the Detective had been discourteous in the treatment of the other Detective.

Summary

There were no citizen's complaints received during 2010 compared to one (1) citizen's complaint received in 2009.

There was one (1) internal investigation conducted in 2010 involving an Investigations Division employee, which was the same number from the previous year.

An analysis of all the 2010 investigations further disclosed:

- Policy violations accounted for the one (1) Professional Standards investigation involving an Investigations Division employee.
- One (1) investigation was partially Sustained with the employee receiving discipline.

There does not appear to be any discernable pattern with regard to the nature of the complaints, indicating that there is no particular area of concern within the Maricopa County Attorneys Office Investigations Division.
