SAFETY TIPS

Create a habit of regularly assessing your work and your work environment, especially during high stress or high workload situations.

Observe warning signs! Is there unusual or threatening behavior or speech at your place of work?

If you're being followed, walk to a store, restaurant, or gas station. These are considered safe places and can help you.

Beware of anything out of place on or near your car. This could be used to get you out of your vehicle.

While on the road, scan for hazards and traffic including weather conditions.

In a public area, avoid distractions such as texting, wearing headphones, or being on your cell phone.
